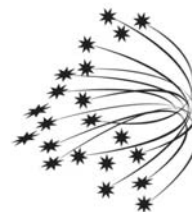
McLachlan has confronted severe writer's block, tour 'rage', and being accused of being a closet gay in the press. She hates the celebrity life and she has good reason.

She's raised millions of dollars for charities and had her picture on the cover of Rolling Stone. All of this by the time she was thirty-two years old, and yet, all she really wanted to do was sing and have a baby.
