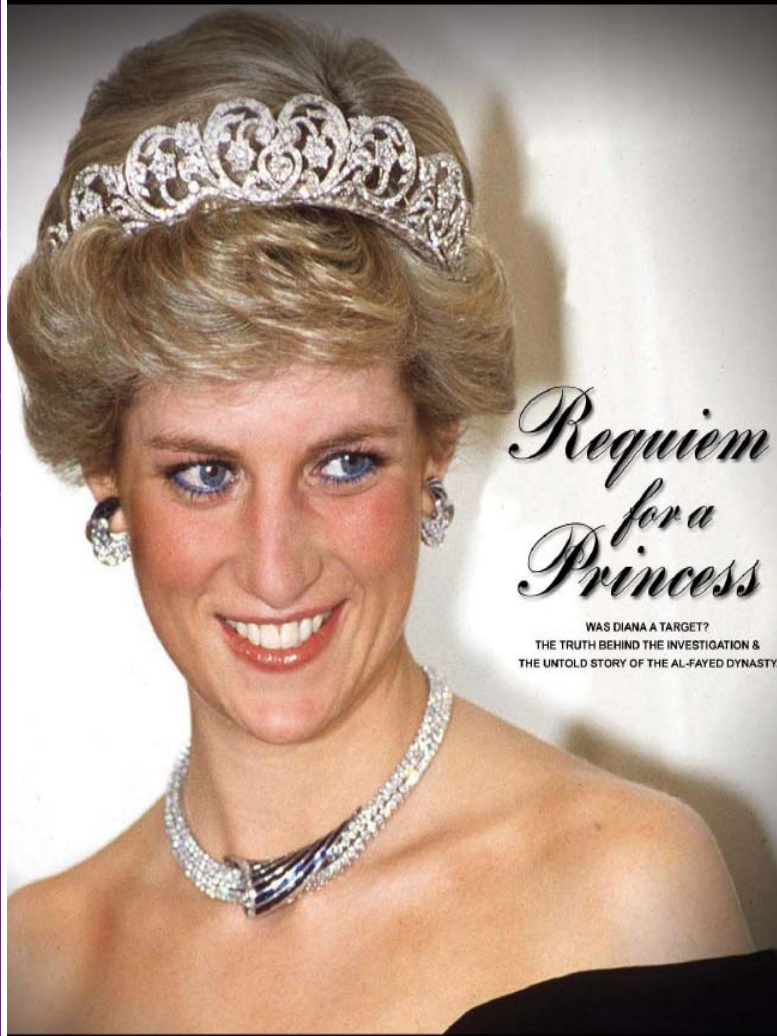

SYNOPSIS

Two and a half billion viewers watched her funeral on television. Ten years later, in spite of two separate official inquiries, closely followed by an enormous press and TV coverage, the cause of the death of Diana, Princess of Wales, remains a complete mystery.

Why is the chauffeur's blood analysis obviously fake, and

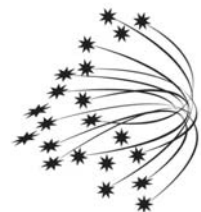
